

Here's what I know...

Intergroup sent this message: Serenity Hall is going to be opening on MAY 7th provided the Governor doesn't make any changes to our re-opening stages for the state.

Area is going to have a virtual convention. June 6th, 2020, and the whole thing will take place on ZOOM. The event will start at 10am and go all day. There will be panelists, two speakers, as well as entertainment and games in the evening. The delegate will share his report from the Virtual GSC, and he is glad to have the platform. No Area business will be conducted, just fun and fellowship.

Pacific Regional Trustee sent this: Last week the Trustees Finance Committee approved and recommended to the GSB a draw down of up to \$3,000,000 from the reserve fund to cover salaries rent and other expenses.

Contributions and Literature sales are way down due to the fallout of Covid 19. For March, Literature sales were budgeted at \$1.2 million and had closer to 200,000. Contributions were budgeted at around \$800,000 and we ended up with around \$380,000. This takes the reserve fund from 9.4 months to 7.2 months. Also encourage groups and members to purchase Carry the message GV's for those that can no longer attend meetings like those behind the walls.
